## Maringka Burton

Place of Birth: (near) Wingellina WA

Language Group: Pitjantjatjara

Maringka Burton was born near the site of the Anumara Tjukurpa (Caterpillar Dreaming), south of Irrunytju (Wingellina) in Western Australia. Maringka lived a traditional Anangu existence with her parents Charlie Tjalkuriny (Charlie Burton) and Naputja Yanyi (Yanyi Burton) and siblings before settling in Ernabella, where Maringka attended the Ernabella Mission school.

Maringka is a highly regarded *ngangkari* (traditional healer), having been guided in this practice by her father Charlie Tjalkuriny. Maringka's *ngangkari* work involves extensive travel and working alongside doctors and nurses to support Anangu patients in hospitals and clinics.

A respected senior artist, Maringka maintains a prolific practice across painting and tjanpi (native grass) weaving.
